

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App Development Camp for Girls

STEM Santa Fe has partnered with the Chicago-based educational organization, Brave Initiative, to bring a new kind of STEM summer day camp to Santa Fe. STEM refers to Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math, areas of learning that are critical to nearly every vocation in today's society. The free summer day camp will be a week-long, hands-on immersion into computer coding and app development. No coding experience is required. The camp will culminate with qualified apps being submitted to the Congressional App Challenge, an annual event that aims to have U.S. students learn to code by having them develop their own apps. STEM Santa Fe invites girls who will be entering eighth and ninth grade to apply for the free day camp, which will take place on the Santa Fe Community College campus from Monday, July 29th through Friday, August 2nd, from 9 AM to 5 PM, (lunch will be provided) and Saturday, August 3rd, from 10 AM to 12 PM. This is a fantastic opportunity for young women to showcase and enhance their coding skills, but please note that participation will be limited to 25 individuals.
